GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

See application for complete details.

Funds are available to recruit retain LPNs and RNs.

Applicant must be a Vermont resident and serve Vermonters at an eligible practice site, as defined by the Program.

Must work as a nurse for a minimum of 18 direct clinical care hours per week for at least 45 weeks/year during the service period.

The practice site, region, or specialty must be a nurse workforce shortage area, as defined by the Program. Priority worksites include critical access hospitals, other hospitals (psychiatric/SUD nurses only), FQHC/CHCs, free clinics (paid employees only), skilled nursing/long term care facilities, home health, mental health, substance use disorder, K-12 public schools, and VT Health Department.

Recipient must sign a service obligation contract for a specific worksite. RNs eligible for one to two-year service commitments; LPNs eligible for a 12-month commitment. Employer matching funds required for RN two-year award.

Grants go directly to pay educational loans.,
